# Virginia Code Sections

46.2-341.4 Definitions 46.2-341.7 Violations / No Proper Endorsements

# Class "A" CDL

 Any combination vehicle over 26,000 lbs., with a towed vehicle exceeding 10,000 lbs.

# Class "B" CDL

 Any vehicle with a gross weight rating of more than 26,000 lbs, with a towed vehicle of 10,000 lbs. or less.

# Class "C" CDL

- Vehicle designed to transport 16 or more passengers including the driver.
- Any vehicle transporting hazardous materials if required to be placarded.

Gross Vehicle Weight Ratings are set by the manufacturer. If not present, then use registration weight.

# State Permit on State Roads Local Permits on Local Roads

#### **Basic Permit Requirements:**

- Red flags on extremities of loads 12" x 12"
- Front & rear oversize load signs
- Amber lights: 360 degree visibility
- If escort vehicles are required, the drivers shall be certified and they are required to have Amber Lights, Oversize Signs, and two-way communications
