WHO WE ARE...

Drive Safe Hampton Roads (DSHR) is a non-profit regional coalition whose mission is to increase the community's involvement and awareness of traffic safety issues.

This organization is made up of individuals from law enforcement, corporate safety, the military, state agencies, safety advocates, fire safety personnel, city and county municipalities, commercial transportation carriers, and individuals with an interest in preventing crashes, injuries, and fatalities on our roadways.

For over 30 years, Drive Safe Hampton Roads has been recognized as a leader in the field of transportation safety and serves as a resource for information and support at the local, state, and national level.

Drive Safe Hampton Roads meets quarterly to provide the latest in transportation safety information to its members. Committees meet to hold planning sessions and informational discussions on current programs, safety issues, and future projects to educate the public on hot topic traffic safety issues.

The John T. Hanna Awards are sponsored by Drive Safe Hampton Roads and are given to recognize Traffic Safety Excellence in Hampton Roads. Award categories include Lifetime Safety Achievement Award, Employer Safety, Martin H. Schlosser Award for Traffic Safety Activism, Impaired Driving Prevention, Law Enforcement Initiatives, Legal, Media, Occupant Protection, Public Transportation Safety, Youth Traffic Safety, and Pupil Transportation Safety. Information and nomination forms may be found on the Drive Safe Hampton Roads website (drivesafehr.org) that caters to its individual members and member agencies. The website provides access to traffic safety links, newsletters, calendars, directions, Good Times Guide posters, and a multitude of other resources.

WHAT WE DO...

Committees...

The **Occupant Protection Committee** develops programs to educate the public about occupant protection issues. Occupant Protection includes the Get It Together (GIT) High School Seat Belt Challenge, the Old, Used, Borrowed and Abused Child Safety Seat Round-Up, regional child safety seat checks, and Senior Driver issues.

The **Impaired Driving Prevention Committee** works to develop programs to educate the public regarding the dangers of driving impaired, such as alcohol/drug use, under-age drinking, aggressive driving, fatigued, and distracted driving. This committee has developed Good Times Guide posters for use in both the general population and in the military community. It also participates in the Every 15 Minutes Program.

The **Specialized Transportation Safety Committee** is a committee that focuses on promoting safe movement practices and traffic safety within the motor carrier community. This includes Driver Appreciation Days, the Virginia Specialized Transportation Safety and Management Conference (VSTSMC), public education and awareness, overweight / over-dimensional permitting information, and general motor carrier safety. There are several subcommittees that address specific areas of traffic safety and the motor carrier community, i.e. Law Enforcement.

The **Membership & Development Committee** serves to recruit, retain, and educate the membership and volunteers. This includes the Speaker's Bureau, Resource Development, John T. Hanna Traffic Safety Awards, social media and online resources.

The **Peninsula Drive Safe Committee** provides a forum for members and invited guests to share information about traffic safety and injury prevention resources, events, and efforts on the Peninsula. This includes involvement in community events, child safety seat checks, Driver Appreciation Days, children's festivals, car classics, etc.
