CHILD SAFETY SEAT INSTALLATION



Parents, grandparents, and anyone else who drives with young children in the car should be able to handle child safety seats properly. That's why AAA offers free child safety seat checks, during which trained technicians will make sure your child's car seat is installed safely and correctly.

AAA offers appointments for child safety seat checks from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Make an appointment at 757-233-3889.

FACT: The first seat belt for vehicles was designed for taxis, meant to keep New York City tourists safe as they saw the sights. In 1959, when Nils Bohlin, a former aerospace engineer who worked for Volvo, invented the three-point seatbelt. The federal government made seat belts mandatory in all new cars in 1968. In 1974, New York passed the first law requiring they be used by those riding in the front seat.



DRIVE SMART Virginia is excited to announce that the 9th Annual Distracted Driving Summit will be held on August 18-19, 2022 at the Hilton Norfolk The Main. There was a great response to the hybrid Summit last year.

The Summit will offer both in-person and virtual options for attendees this year as well. Drive Safe Hampton Roads is known for its commitment to safety, so reach out to your colleagues with this year's sponsorship opportunities. Please note that DRIVE SMART Virginia is looking for a parking sponsor this year. This sponsor will allow DRIVE SMART Virginia to cover the cost of parking at the Summit property for all attendees. The City of Norfolk operates the parking lot and thus we were not able to negotiate a lower rate into our hotel contract.

This Summit continues to be an extremely important event as traffic deaths are on the rise. The National Highway Traffic Safety reported that the first half of 2021 saw the largest six-month increase ever recorded in the Fatality Analysis Reporting System's history. The first half of 2021 saw an 18.4% increase over 2020. That's the largest number of projected fatalities in that time period since 2006. Secretary Pete Buttigieg has called it a "crisis" and says "we cannot and should not accept these fatalities as simply a part of everyday life in America."
