10th ANNUAL DISTRACTED DRIVING SUMMIT

The Summit will be held on **September 13-14, 2023**, at the Virginia Tech Inn and Conference **Center!** This event focuses on bringing together top experts across the nation to discuss the best strategies, research, technology, enforcement efforts, etc. toward eradicating distracted driving. The event is needed more than ever as the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration recently reported that distracted driving crashes cost Americans \$98.2 billion in 2019, accounting for about 29% of all crash costs. Events such as the Distracted Driving Summit are critical to educating communities on effective measures to decrease crashes and deaths on our roadways.

On average, a DUI (of any substance) could set you back \$10,000 in attorney's fees, fines, court costs, lost time at work, higher insurance rates, and more.

- * 5,579 motorcyclists were killed in traffic crashes in 2020, an 11% increase from 2019 (5,044).
- * Motorcyclist deaths accounted for 14% of the total highway fatalities in 2020.

FACT:

In 2020, there were 938 bicyclists killed - a 9% increase from 2019 - and an estimated 38,886 injured in traffic crashes in the United States.

FACT:



If you see a bicyclist, slow down: Bicyclists are most often killed by drivers who strike them with the front of their vehicles, often at high speeds. The higher the vehicle speed, the higher the likelihood a bicyclist will be seriously injured or killed.

NATIONAL SEAT BELT ENFORCEMENT MOBILIZATION MAY 22 - JUNE 4, 2023

Seat belts have been proven to be one of the best ways to save your life in a crash. Yet many still don't buckle up. Worse still, not wearing a seat belt is a habit that will pass on to impressionable youth who, in turn, will think it is safe not to buckle up.

The Click It or Ticket campaign focuses on safety education, strong laws, and law enforcement support to save lives. **Dates to Remember:** May 22 - June 4, 2023 (enforcement period)

NATIONAL HEATSTROKE PREVENTION DAY IS MAY 1, 2023



Heatstroke is the leading cause of non-traffic, non-crash-related fatalities for children 14 and younger. Already this year, two children have died from heatstroke in a hot car, bringing the total to 942 children since 1998. Yet, this tragedy is 100% preventable.

A MESSAGE FROM DMV

Since the beginning of the new year, Virginia has seen a 150% increase in fatal bicycle crashes, tragically losing five bicyclists on Virginia roadways. Please see the preliminary data below.

MOVE OVER LAW TO EXPAND IN VIRGINIA

Changes are coming to the Move Over Law in Virginia. Governor Glenn Youngkin signed into law an expansion to include any stationary vehicle on the side of the road with hazard lights or warning signs, such as an emergency triangle or flares.

According to AAA, 28 people were killed in crashes in the Commonwealth while outside disabled vehicles between 2016 and 2020.

If you see a vehicle like this, drivers will need to slow down and try to make a lane change if it's safe to do so. The expansion of the law will go into effect on July 1.
